What is Job Corps?

A government funded program that provides education and vocational training for youth ages 16-24 at no-cost.

Job Corps is administered by the U.S. Department of Labor and is funded by the United States Congress. It was established in 1964.

What to expect on center?

- Live in a campus type setting in dormitories, 4-6 per room
- Structured environment to teach you life/work skills
- 6am wakeup, 10pm curfew
- Assigned chores and duties
- Education/training hours 8-4pm, 2 breaks & hr lunch
- Uniforms during training hrs.
- If 18 and older, cigarette smoking is permitted in designated areas
- You will NOT be permitted off center for first 30 days
- Hair must be a natural color
- No body jewelry/piercing permitted, except earrings
- No musical instruments, cars, bikes, skateboards permitted
- Bring at own risk: cell phone, MP3/iPOD, etc..

Benefits

- Self-paced program
- Free housing, education and vocational training, (study up to 3 trades, maximum time is 2 yrs)
- Free basic healthcare, dentistry and vision
- Free meals & snacks
- Free drivers license
- Free tutoring
- \$25 biweekly stipend increases over time
- Clothing allowance
- Two paid vacations each year, off holidays
- Recreational activities (on and off center)
- Career assistance up to 1 year after graduating
- Up to \$1000 graduation bonus to use as you like
- Advanced training and community college options, if eligible
- Preparation for military
- Become independent
- Gain life & work skills
- Positively change life & gain a multi-cultural awareness.

Required Documents

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- State ID
- Immunization Records
- Copy of last HS Transcripts, Diploma/GED, & last IEP, if applicable
- Income Verification (check stub, food share etc.)
- If you are a parent and have sole custody of your child (ren) you MUST provide birth certificate & social security card.
- Medical documentation for medication/treatment
- Copy of Health Ins. Card
- Minors: Parent/guardian must be at interview. Guardians need court documentation.
- Application Packet

Incomplete applications will NOT be processed. Application materials are due 2 weeks from today.

If not received, your paperwork will be shredded, and you must reapply.

The following are NOT permitted on center and are grounds for immediate dismissal from Job Corps!

- Violence
- Drug or alcohol use
- Sexual misconduct
- Harassment
- Possession of weapon, ammunition, explosives
- Gambling
- Persistent disobedience of center rules/regulations
- Repeated or prolonged absences from classes
- Improper use of center facilities and equipment
- Unreasonable standards of personal appearance and cleanliness
- Maintenance or operation of a private vehicle
- Leaving the center without permission
